

# Autumn Scarf

**Yarn:** 4 x Fiori Grande (shown in Sequoia)

**Needles:** 9.00mm Needles and a crochet hook for fringing

**Size:**

length (without fringe) 180cm, width 24cm

**Tension:** 9 stitches and 26 rows per 10cm square in fisherman's rib

**Fisherman's Rib:**

Foundation Row: Knit all stitches

Row 1: \* knit 1, knit 1 in row below (you will pull both the worked stitch and the stitch above off the needle together), repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, knit 2. Repeat 1st row throughout.

Cast on 20sts.

Work first and last stitch in Garter (knit) stitch as a selvedge and the remaining 34 stitches in Fisherman's Rib until scarf measures 180cm from cast on edge.

Bind off all stitches loosely

Using remaining yarn, add 17 evenly spaced fringes along each short edge. cut 50cm long pieces for a fringe on both short edges. Holding 3 strands, fold in half and attach from the right side by pushing the fold through the stitch and threading the ends through the loop. Repeat evenly across the width of your scarf.
