

Yarn: MC: 2 x Fiori DK IV (shown in Tortoise Shell) CC: 2 x Fiori Grande (shown in Silver Dawn)

Needles:10.00mm Circular needles (120cm long)

Using DK IV, cast on 170sts.

Work several row in garter stitch (knit all stitches) then break yarn.

Using Grande , knit 2 rows, break yarn. Re-attach DK IV and work several rows, break yarn.

Using Grande, knit 2 rows, break yarn. Continue working in this manner until scarf measures 28cm wide. Bind off all stitches loosely

Using remaining yarn, cut 40cm long pieces for a fringe on both short edges. Holding 2 strands of each yarn, fold in half and attach from the right side by pushing the fold through the stitch and threading the ends through the loop. repeat this with a single 'tassel for every 2 rows of knitting, utilising the yarn ends already there. Size:

length (with fringes) 230cm, width 28cm

Tension: 7 stitches per 10cm

This project allows freedom to play with colour and striping, There will be approx 7 rounds of Grande and 58 rows of DK IV. For even stripes, work 2 rows of double Grande for every 8 rows of DK IV

Note: leave approx 15cm of yarn tail when changing colours-this will be used in the fringe

The pattern of the sample is:

Cast on with DK Grande - knit 1 row DK IV - knit 2 rows Grande - knit 2 rows DK IV - knit 2 rows Grande - knit 2 rows DK IV - knit 11 rows Grande - knit 1 row DK IV - knit 2 rows Grande - knit 2 rows DK IV - knit 5 rows Grande - knit 2 rows DK IV - knit 9 rows Grande - knit 2 rows DK IV - knit 2 rows DK IV - knit 2 rows Grande - knit 1 row DK IV - knit 2 rows DK IV - knit 2 rows DK IV - knit 2 rows
